The first Study Club Meeting of the year was held on Thursday March 5 at the Monroe Hotel in Beirut. Guest speaker Dr Alfred Naaman's presentation covered the limitations of the use of calcium hydroxide in endodontic treatment, and the reasons for which this procedure was being phased out.

Fellow Dr George Bellos spoke about the techniques available for the restoration of pulpless teeth pointing out the importance of a minimal height of dentin ferrule to minimize the risk of root fracture.
